Dear Delta Cable customer:

Delta Cable is committed to keeping our customers entertained, connected and informed about upcoming changes to products and services. When ABC, NBC, CBS, KCTS, CW11, KVOS, FOX and ShopNBC transition to digital broadcasting on February 17th, viewers who receive these channels via rabbit ears will require a converter box.

As a Delta Cable customer, you will NOT be impacted by this change. You will not require a digital box to receive these services from Delta Cable.

Pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules we provide you with the following notice:

After Feb. 17, 2009, a television receiver with only an analog broadcast tuner will require a converter box to receive over-the-air U.S. broadcasts with an antenna because of the U.S. transition to digital broadcasting. This ONLY affects those who use "rabbit ears" and not cable television customers. Delta Cable customers will continue to receive the services they currently subscribe to and no set-top box or other special equipment is necessary. Analog-only TVs should continue to work as before with cable and satellite TV services, gaming consoles, VCRs, DVD players, and similar products.
